Between 1993-1997 Mr Trenin was a Senior Research Fellow at the European Institute in Moscow. In 1993 he was a Senior Research Fellow at the NATO Defense College in Rome.

From 1972 to 1993 he served in the Soviet and Russian armed forces, working as a liaison officer in the area of external relations of the combined Soviet armed forces (stationed in Potsdam) and was a member of the US-Soviet delegation attending disarmament talks in Geneva between 1985 and 1991. He taught at the War Studies Faculty of the Military Institute between 1986 and 1993.

Trenin is a member of numerous institutes and organisations, including the International Institute for Strategic Studies (since 1992), The Russian International Studies Association (since 1999), the Advisory Board of the journal Pro et Contra (since 1996), and the Expert Committee of the Moscow School of Political Studies (since 2000). He is author, co-author and editor of numerous publications.
